The situation in Haiti is a horror almost beyond our ability to imagine. But we need to try to imagine ourselves in the same situation. Ask yourself if you have supplies to last at least three days on your own without electricity or help from others. Think about putting together an emergency kit for your home and possibly your car and work. Should an earthquake or other disaster occur, you will need water, food (for yourself, your family, and even pets), flashlights, batteries, medical supplies, blankets, etc. (whatever you use on a daily basis). A clean plastic garbage tub makes a good container for your supplies.

- 1 – bar of soap (bath size in wrapper)
- 1 – toothbrush (in original packaging)
- 6 – Band-Aids or other adhesive bandage strips
